GOLD MEDAL (SCRATCH) 36 HOLES SILVER MEDAL (HANDICAP) 18 HOLES OPEN TO PLAYERS WITH HANDICAPS OF 12 AND UNDER

CONDITIONS

1. The Competition will be open to amateur golfers who are members of recognised golf clubs. Entries for the Gold and Silver Medals will be limited to handicaps of 12 and under.
 2. All Competitors will play one round in the morning. Those entered in the Gold Medal will play a second round in the afternoon. Play will be in accordance with the Rules of Golf and Local Rules.
 3. Entries will be limited to 100. If this is exceeded, higher handicaps will be balloted out. Closing date for entries will be Friday 6th August 2021
 4. All entries must be lodged with the GHC Secretary on an official digital or paper entry form. Paper forms are available from moira@golfhouseclub.org. Your entry fee of £20 for both Medals or £15 for Silver Medal must accompany your entry. Starting times will be emailed to you after the 6th August closing date and published on our website at www.golfhouseclub.co.uk
Please note: No entries will be accepted without payment of the entry fee.
 5. Play will commence at 7.30am or earlier if required.
 6. The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry or alter or amend any of the conditions and its decision in all disputes will be final.
 7. The Competitor returning the best scratch score over 36 holes will receive the Gold Medal and the competitor returning the best handicap score over the 1st 18 holes will receive the Silver Medal. Trophies will be retained by the Committee. Replicas will be presented.
In addition, there will be the following prizes:

1 st Scratch Prize – Voucher £300	1 st Handicap – Voucher £150
2 nd Scratch Prize – Voucher £200	2 nd Handicap – Voucher £100
3 rd Scratch Prize – Voucher £150	3 rd handicap – Voucher £60
4 th Scratch Prize – Voucher £100	4 th Handicap – Voucher £40
 8. In the event of a tie for the Gold Medal, there will be a “sudden death” play off over the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 18th holes in that order. In the event of a tie for the Silver Medal, the best inward nine holes will decide, failing which the last six or three holes will be the deciding factor. The value of the vouchers for tied places in both classes will be shared equally.
 9. A bar/snack lunch will be available at the Clubhouse and competitors are asked to indicate on entry forms whether this is desired to enable us to meet catering requirements. Dress in the Mixed Lounge is smart casual and in the Members Lounge jacket, collar and tie.
 10. **Slow play may be penalised.**
- N.B. Players are requested to ensure that their dress on the course is in keeping with the standards of the Club. For guidance, the wearing of demin jeans, collarless tee shirts, replica football shirts, beach shorts and the like is **not** acceptable. If players chose to wear tailored golfing shorts, knee length socks are also required to be worn.
